



PUBLIC NOTICE OF OPENING THE WAITING LIST

BOISE CITY/ADA COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY

On August 20, 2018, the Boise City/Ada County Housing Authority (BCACHA) will begin accepting pre-applications for placement on the Low Rent Public Housing and Multifamily waiting list.

Capitol Plaza, Franklin Plaza, and Shoreline Plaza consist of studio, one bedroom, and two bedroom apartments and applicants must meet the following qualifications to be eligible:

- The household must be low-income (80% or below Area Median Income), AND
- Applicant must be a person who has U.S. Citizenship or eligible immigration status; AND
- The household must be one where the Head of Household, co-head or spouse are age 62 or older, OR the Head of Household, co-head or spouse are disabled

Scattered site public housing consists of two bedroom and three bedroom homes. Applicants must meet the following qualifications to be eligible:

- The household must be low-income (80% or below the Area Median Income), AND
- The household must be one where the Head of Household, co-head or spouse are age 62 or older; OR the Head of Household, co-head or spouse are disabled; OR is a person working 20 hours or more weekly; AND
- Has U.S Citizenship or eligible immigration status.

Applications to determine preliminary eligibility will be available to the public on August 20, 2018 at the Boise City/Ada County Housing Authority at 1276 River Street, Suite 300, Boise, Idaho, 83702, or available online at www.bcacha.org.
